



WRTA to Hold Meetings about Service Improvements and New Transfer Facility at Union Station

The Worcester Regional Transit Authority (WRTA) will be holding public meetings to discuss and make the public aware of a variety of initiatives that the Authority is currently undertaking. These initiatives include the purchasing of new buses to replace existing older ones, installation of new fare boxes, upcoming installation of Intelligent Transit Technology (such as Automated Vehicles Announcement and Automated Vehicle Locator systems) and the Authority's plans to construct a new transfer facility at Union Station.

"These initiatives will help bring the WRTA into the 21st Century and create a first-rate transit system in Worcester," said WRTA Administrator Stephen O'Neil. "These initiatives are helping us to build a framework for statewide transit interoperability with the MBTA and other surrounding RTA's in the future."
