Board of Health Members present: Rodney Foisy, Robert Bradshaw, Dan Shields

Staff present: Lee Jarvis

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: **September 14, 2015** – *A motion to approve the minutes (Shields/Bradshaw) passed 3/0.*

Rustic Lane – LUA – Mr. Jarvis explained the plan. The soil absorption system is 56' to the well. The Board reviewed the plan. *A motion to approve the plan (Shields/Bradshaw) passed 3/0.*

102 Wilson Road – LUA – Foisy: Mr. Jarvis explained the plan. The soil absorption system is 56' to the well and 16' to the foundation. The Board reviewed the plan. *A motion to approve the plan (Bradshaw/Shields) passed 2/0. Mr. Foisy abstained.*

25 Chickering Road – LUA – Sanderson: Mr. Jarvis explained the plan. The soil absorption system is 60', 75' and 90' to surrounding wells, 10' to the foundation, and 35' from the tank to the well. The Board reviewed the plan. *A motion to approve the plan (Shields/Foisy) passed 3/0.*

Solid Waste Regulations: Mr. Jarvis said the regulations will be posted in the New Leader and voted on at the December meeting. *A motion to post the Solid Waste Haulers Regulations (Foisy/Bradshaw) passed 3/0.*

Recycling Bins: Mr. Jarvis said people are using the recycling bins around town for their trash. Mr. Jarvis gave Laney's two tickets this summer and the one by the high school has trash in it. Mr. Jarvis said that anyone who has one of these recycle bins should be responsible for it and to keep just recyclables in it, no garbage. Mr. Jarvis will see if a regulation can be done at a Board of Health Meeting. Mr. Jarvis will also inquire with other towns as to how they regulate the bins. *A motion to allow Mr. Jarvis to investigate the Recycle Bins (Foisy/Bradshaw) passed 3/0.*

Grease Removal Systems: Mr. Jarvis said he has a letter from DEP stating that one of the deficiencies is grease. Mr. Jarvis said we need a new regulation requiring grease removal systems in all food establishments, as it is causing a serious problem for our treatment plant and their DEP permitting. There is also clogging of the secondary treatment process. Mr. Jarvis will research.

A motion to adjourn at 7:15 p.m. (Bradshaw/Shields) passed 3/0.
