Minutes & Correspondence

Restaurant Inspections: Mr. Jarvis said all the restaurant inspections must be done by the end of this month. Due to the upcoming H1N1 clinics and getting all correspondence ready for the clinics, Mr. Jarvis has not been able to do the inspections. Mr. Jarvis asked that the Board allow him to hire Mr. Richard Gobi to do the restaurant inspections. The money to pay Mr. Gobi will come out of the PHER Grant. *A motion to allow Richard Gobi to inspect the restaurants (Shields/Foisy) passed 3/0.*

H1N1 Clinics: The clinics are starting this week. The schools are being done on Wednesday, December 9th and Thursday, December 10th from 8am until 2pm. Only the flu mist will be given to the children at the schools unless otherwise directed by the parent. Also on Wednesday and Thursday, there will be clinics at the Town Hall from 3pm until 7pm for anyone with health conditions, pregnant women and households with children under 18 years of age.

On December 30th, an H1N1 clinic will be held from 10am until 6pm at Wire Village School for college students ages 18-24 and for anyone with health conditions. As soon as more vaccines are received, more clinics will be scheduled.
