## Infrastructure funding:

- Congressmen McGovern announced 12 billion secured for various Infrastructure funding for Mass. Will be compiling a list statewide projects & doing some prioritization. As soon as State Administration & Finance has secured funding, Bills will be introduced to prioritize Spencer as a shovel ready project. Tighe & Bond tentatively scheduled for late Jan., Feb Bid release. Spencer is on the initial IUP (Intended Use Plan) for SRF Funding and awaiting inclusion on round 2. Estimated 24 months active construction & another two months for punch list.
- SSES should be complete by Aug. 2022. Looking to submit grant application to MCWT (Mass. Clean Water Trust) in August 2022. Earliest Collections system rehab work would be 2023.
