## 7:19 p.m. Continuation of the Public Hearing to Amend the Order of Conditions for CDW Consultants, Inc.

#### Property: 92 McCormick Road, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0922

At the request of the applicant, the hearing has been continued to April 10, 2019.

### <u>7:20 p.m. Opened the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for the Town of Spencer</u>

#### Property: Hastings Road Bridge, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0956 SW Permit

Thaddeus Soule from Beals & Thomas presented the plans. The plan is to remove concrete barriers and put in a new bridge. Turkey Hill Brook is a Cold Water Fishery. Mr. Bellemer wanted to know if the 17-inch pipe that dumps water into the brook is going to remain. Mr. Soule said that the pipe will remain. The headwall is sound. Steven Tyler asked to see the wing walls on the plan. He stated the deep sump catch basin will be an improvement. Mr. Soule explained there will be an oil boom in place, 40-ft downstream of the area where heavy equipment will operate. Ms. Washburn read the special conditions.

### 7:41 p.m. Opened the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for William Delude Property: 10 Blueberry Hill Drive, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0958

Keith Terry of Sherman & Frydryk presented the plan for a proposed garage on the side of the house. Roof runoff will be directed into a proposed rain garden. Mr. Terry would like to have wattles. Ms. Washburn and the Commission prefer hay bales because there will be considerable digging and a steep slope.

# <u>7:45 p.m. Opened the Public Meeting for the Request for Determination of Applicability for Francis White</u>

### Property: 25 Kingsbury Road, Spencer, MA

Francis White Jr., Frank White and Ed Pilling were present in regards to the fill that was dumped in the buffer zone without a permit. They were not aware that they did anything wrong. They would like to rectify the problem. Mr. Pilling would like to move rocks up by his house and build a stone wall. The Commission received a complaint. Ms. McLaughlin read the inspection report. The Commission decided on an Enforcement Order to get the specified work done by April 9, 2019. The wetlands need to be delineated and a plan submitted by June 5, 2019.

At the request of the applicant, the hearing has been continued to June 12, 2019.

### 8:18 p.m. Opened the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for Bill Krukowski Property: Thompson Pond Road near #40, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0955 SW Permit

Lori Benoit from Stantec Engineering presented the plans. The project will improve drainage off of Thompson Pond Road. There is flooding at 40 & 42 Thompson Pond Road. Hot mix asphalt curbing will be installed. A short paved drainage channel will funnel water into a basin. Kathryn Pike wanted to know what riprap was used for and a discussion followed.

### 8:30 p.m. Opened the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for Bill Krukowski Property: Greenville Street near #166 west Kingsbury Road, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0957 SW Permit

Lori Benoit presented the plans for this project. An abutter, Richard Dyer has had drainage issues ever since his house was built. Previous town road work caused his driveway to heave up. He stated he wished he could have had a catch basin years ago. Ms Benoit showed Mr. Dyer the plans. Mr. Dyer said that this will be an improvement to the road.

### **Other Business:**

**Barry Arsenault re: 9 Point Eastalee:** Mr.Arsenault came in to discuss his neighbor Matt Klanseks' land. He said Mr. Klansek wants to put up a barrier wall and to fill in land near the lake. Mr. Arsenault had Glenn Krevosky come out to the property last year. Mr. Krevosky told him there were 55 feet of wetlands. Mr. Arsenault was supposed to receive a report from Mr. Krevosky but he never got one. Mr. Arsenault took pictures of the wetland flowers that Mr. Krevosky pointed out to him. Mr. Arsenault said that Mr. Klansek had moved rocks in the water onto the dock. Ms. Washburn had received a call from Mr. Klansek in regards to a dock he wanted to remove down by the water. Ms. Washburn had told Mr. Klansek to file an RDA.

<u>86 Wilson Street NOV – Joseph Ford:</u> Ms. Washburn received a complaint stating that many trees, stumps and brush were removed in the fall of 2018 without a permit. It caused sediment to wash into a stream that flows under Rustic Lane. Scott Morrison wrote a letter in regards to the stabilization plan. The Commission requires a remediation plan and sketch by June 1, 2019. The work is to be done under an Enforcement Order.

**<u>25 Kingsbury Road NOV – Ed Pilling:</u>** Ms. Washburn told Mr. Pilling that he received the Notice of Violation because he is the owner of the property where Franny White dumped fill. Mr. Pilling wanted to make a pasture. He would have to file an NOI because new agriculture is not exempt from the Wetlands Protection Act. Mr. Pilling asked the Commission if they saw the culvert on Kingsbury Road. Mr. Pilling said that when the town put the culvert in it washed out soil four feet deep.
