4.0 Public Hearing/Meetings

4.1 7:05 p.m. Continued the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for Bertin Engineering

Property: Charlton & Bacon Hill Roads, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0984

The applicant's representatives Steve Pikul and T.J. Recupero joined the hearing. Mr. Russell said that they have received confirmation that the plans being reviewed by Planning Board, ConCom and BSC are not the same. BSC has scheduled a site walk with the applicant to complete the delineation review. Mr. Pikul said that the plans are the most current for all boards. Mr. Perry asked Mr. Pikul if the plans were the same plans as the ones he saw at the site walk. Mr. Pikul said they were the same plans. Mr. Russell looked at the plans and discovered the dates were current. There was discrepancy in where the dates were put on the plans.

4.4 7:34 p.m. Continued the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for Richard Leveille

Property: Hastings Road, Map 43, Parcel 16.1, Spencer, MA DEP#293-1008

Mr. Russell said we have not received the drainage report.

Mark Elbag said that he sent the stormwater report and updated plans via email. There was discussion about whether the plans were submitted to BSC as well. They have not submitted to BSC.

4.5 7:39 p.m. Opened the Public Hearing for the Request to Amend the Order of Conditions for Louis Mattei

Property: 96 Pleasant Street, Spencer, MA DEP#293-0961

Louis Mattei joined the meeting. Mr. Mattei had a few questions due to the spring thaw. He said the snow plow came through and tore up the edge of his driveway. He wants to put pavers down. Mr. Russell said that if there is going to be changes to the plans, they need to update the plans and continue the meeting. Mr. Russell suggested putting grass seed down. There was discussion about the location of the shed and firepit on the plans. The Commission recommended a scale and dimensions on the plans.

4.6 7:50 Opened the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent for John Kennedy Property: 48 East Charlton Road, Spencer, MA DEP#293-1010

Jason Dubois joined the hearing. Mr. Dubois discussed the project. Mr. Russell said that we have received comments from DEP concerning the possibility of a vernal pool. The applicant has retained EcoTec. Mr. Russell said that a forest cutting plan was approved in 2020 for this lot. Under sec.16.4 of the wetlands by-law, any tree cutting on the lot is prohibited for 5 years from the termination of the FCP, which will be in 2024 or 2025. Mr. Russell said that until the issues are resolved, and the revised plans are submitted, the application should not go forward. Mr. Dubois said that the trees that they want to cut are not in the wetlands. He feels the by-law is flawed. The Town Attorney has ruled that the first sentence of sec. 16.4 is valid. There was a discussion about rewording that section of the by-law at a Town Meeting. Mr. Russell recommended that the applicant work out the technical issues for the next meeting.

At the request of the applicant, the hearing has been continued to April 14, 2021.
