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REQUIRED NOTIFICATION & PERMIT PROCEDURES FOR EXCAVATIONS

Minimum required steps to performing an excavation (includes any/all soil disturbances) in the Town of Spencer pursuant to Massachusetts Dig Safe Laws and Town of Spencer Bylaws.

- 1. The excavator visits the site, marks out every place he may be excavating with white paint, flags, or stakes.
- 2. The excavator fills out all the information about the excavation on a Locate Request Form (available for download at www.digsafe.com) then calls in the stake-out request to Dig Safe (call "811").
- 3. The Dig Safe Customer Service Representative takes the information, gives the excavator a Dig Safe Ticket Number and a list of member facility owners notified. The Dig Safe Customer Service Representative then informs the excavator that pursuant to state law he/she must also notify non-member utilities at least 3 business days in advance of excavation. The Town of Spencer is NOT a member utility therefore; all excavators are required to notify the Spencer Utilities & Facilities Office at least 3 business days in advance of an excavation includes all excavations of any kind or depth on all private and/or public property.
- 4. The excavator then completes a Driveway/Street Occupancy/Trench Permit Request Appendix B of <u>Attachment #1 Rules and Specifications for Excavation within the Town of Spencer</u> and available from the Spencer Utilities & Facilities Office or online at:

<u>Permit Request for private and public excavations</u> should be completed to include the excavation Dig Safe No., location of excavation/project, project start date and all other required information. A valid Certificate of Liability, see page 8 of <u>Attachment #1 Sec 3.03</u>, documenting that the minimum insurance requirements are met should be included with the completed Permit as applicable.

<u>Trench Permit Fee</u> is required on an annual basis for the total cost of \$100.00 for all trench excavations of more than 3 feet in depth. Permit Fees can be found on page 27 of Attachment #1.

- 5. Each utilities department of the Town of Spencer then marks out the facilities it maintains in the area of excavation.
- 6. While working, the excavator takes care to find and maintain any markings that have been placed. When digging near a buried facility, the excavator observes the tolerance zone around that facility.
- 7. If exposing a facility, the excavator provides proper support and protection for it so that the facility will not be damaged.
- 8. When the excavation is complete, the excavator provides proper backfill for any facilities that have been exposed, and removes all utility markings.
