- Debbie Kirk retired from her position as Children's Librarian on August 9<sup>th</sup>. An open house was held in her honor. Amy Paul accepted the position of Children's Library Assistant.

- Walks with the Librarians continue to be popular, held on Tuesday mornings from 8:30-9:30.
- The front door and steps are being restored.
