Discuss Sewer Rates Increase:

Review Tighe & Bond Sewer System Rate Evaluation. Rates will be reevaluated each year to
meet appropriation for the upgrade at Wastewater Treatment Plant. These increases are necessary
to pay for operations, maintenance and upgrade to the sewer systems. Sewer is an Enterprise
Funds paid by sewer users only. Also, traditionally more expensive to run the Sewer plant then
Water due to higher energy, chemical, mechanical processes. Sewer Commissioners are trying to
reduce cost to user.

Resident questions and answers:

• Support from local and state officials for funding. Wright-Pierce and Tighe & Bond are pursuing any available grants or funding sources.

Larry made a motion to increase sewer user fee by 25% for FY2024 effective April 1, 2023, starting the fourth quarter (April 2023), Francis Jr. second the motion, all in favor, Frank. with a roll call vote: Larry-yes, Francis Jr.-yes, Frank-yes.
