Budget & Capital items:

- Discuss having Tighe-bond do a sewer rate study proposal. Sewer Commissioners would like to take this under advisement.
- Discuss hiring Laborer but might have to look for Chief Operator. Sewer Commissioners would like to take this under advisement. Will review this again before April.
- Review sewer rates and retained earnings. Retain earnings is higher this fiscal year because of the Covid-19. Sewer projects haven't been started but monies have been allocation for the projects. Sewer rate increase has been tabled until further notice.

Sewer Systems Upgrades:

• Lake Street Senior Housing project. Sewer Dept. have not been successful to identify a source that would quantify the removal percentage of 4:1 for the Lake St proposal. Also, the Spencer Board of Sewer Commissioners did vote on a moratorium 9/22 of any projects not to exceed 440 gallons per day of design flow.

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Resident Concerns:

- 38 Lincoln St high usage toilet was leaking (fixed) requesting abatement for sewer. Mike motion not to abate sewer portion of the bill, seconded by Larry and in favor, Frank. Passed with a roll call vote: Larry-yes, Mike-yes, Frank-yes.
- 103 Mechanic St requesting to have sewer late fee waived. Larry motion to waive the \$15.00 late fee, seconded by Frank and in favor, Mike. Passed with a roll call vote: Larry-yes, Mike-yes, Frank-yes.
- 1 Duggan St requesting to have sewer late fee waived. Mike motion to waive the \$15.00 late fee for one time only, seconded by Frank and in favor, Larry. Passed with a roll call vote: Larry-yes, Mike-yes, Frank-yes.
- 47 Ash St requesting to have sewer late fee waived (stating mailed payment on time). Larry motion to waive the \$15.00 late fee for one time only, seconded by Frank and not in favor, Mike. Passed 2/1 with a roll call vote: Larry-yes, Mike-no, Frank-yes.
