• Sewer Commissioners discuss #1 and #3 Lake Whittemore Dr. connection, would like to amend September 12, 2018 minutes. New proposal to install a manhole and run a single 8" line to Rt.9. This would allow possible future expansion of Sewer system in that area with a possible betterment in the future.

Sewer Systems Upgrade:

- Sewer Commissioner Review maps and data from evaluation study, Highlighting areas of excessive infiltration causing Annual average flow violation. Video inspection of area will be scheduled.
- Nitrogen requirements for NPDES permits on the Long Island Sound Watershed. Aeration
 modifications will be necessary to meet Nitrogen limits, Aeration tanks were taken off the schedule
 earlier in CWMP.
- Tight Bond will be at the Sewer Commissioners meeting July 10, 2019.
- Maintenance garage; working on bid for the garage (40x40x16), Commissioners have approved building, and address Solids Bldg. roof next fiscal year. (FY21).
