

## Budget & Capital Items:

- Review MIIA Grant program statement (confined space entry) grant total is \$6,897.
- Synagro Rhode Island recently implemented a law which charges new tolls for tractor trailers in order to help fund the State's Road Works Program. The toll is \$3.50/load per one-way trip. This new toll fee will be passed through to affected customers and noted separately on a per load basis on bill.

## Sewer Systems Upgrades:

- Dairy Queen grease trap was inspected and has no restrictor valve, and possibly undersized. Sewer Superintendent and Commissioners will follow up with Plumbing Inspector and owner of 291 main St. (Dairy Queen) with cleanup cost and expenses resulting from improper installation.
- Sugden Lake phosphorous issue and future potential tie-in to sanitary sewer system.
- Discuss the Illicit connections of sump pump connection to sanitary sewer. At 8 & 10 Lake St. Resident agrees to remove connection to private system after repair of broken lateral to 10 Lake St.
- Superintendent would like to reschedule January's sewer meeting to January 15, 2019 at 3pm and Wright-Pierce schedule for 4pm.
