The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Minutes: March 4, 2019 – *A motion to approve the minutes as written (Jarvis/Foisy) passed 3/0.*

LUA – 15 West Avenue, Scudder: The plan shows a two-foot reduction is needed in separation between the SAS and high groundwater, and the septic tank is 11' to the well. The Board reviewed and discussed the plan. *A motion to approve the local upgrade plan (Jarvis/Shields) passed 3/0.*

Other Business:

Wire Village School: Ms. Daoust said she received a complaint that there was no heat at Wire Village School due to the boiler not working. She said she called Ed from the maintenance department at the school. He said a technician was scheduled to repair the boiler. Ms. Daoust received a phone call the next day informing her that the boiler was repaired and there was heat.

26 Main Street: Ms. Daoust said she is having a difficult time getting in contact with the town's lawyer. The tenants still do not have water and the town will not turn on the water until the owner repairs the water service and they pay all monies owed to the town. The Board does not want to condemn the property and put the tenants out of their home. *A motion was made that if the town's attorney cannot get this issue into court, the Board of Health will hire an attorney (Jarvis/Foisy) passed 3/0.*

42 Woodside Road: Mr. Foisy said he received another complaint of the rooster at 42 Woodside Road. The owner, Chrissy Cabana, was given permission for a no-crow collar for the rooster. The rooster is still crowing. Ms. Daoust will send a letter to the owners that the rooster must be removed within five days.


