1. The Meeting was opened at 6:15 p.m.

2. Public Hearings/Meetings:

a. 6:15 & 6:32 p.m. Opened the Public Meeting for Request for Determination of Applicability for Lauren Kleciak

Property: 105 Clark Road, Spencer, MA

A neighbor, Jerry Ferguson, arrived at the meeting late. Mr. Bellemer wanted to know if Ms. Kleciak was going to dig down two feet. Mr. Bellemer suggested to dig below the frost line. The issue was that water was flowing from her neighbors' property into the lower level of her home. Ms. Kleciak wants to dig a trench, put a perforated pipe in and

add crushed rock. Ms. Mclaughlin read the inspection report. The Commission would like a boom if hydraulic equipment is going to be used.

Scott Morrison, from Ecotec, Inc. presented the project. The proposed work is for a single-family home, septic system and a driveway. Mr. Morrison discussed the plans. Mr. Snow read the inspection report. The office received the DEP file number today. The Commission agreed to the plans.

c. 6:24 p.m. Opened the Public Meeting for the Request for Determination of Applicability for Steven Blake

Property: 123 Wilson Avenue, Spencer, MA

Mr. Blake told the Commission that the wall down by the water is falling apart. He wants to raise the wall up 6 more inches to prevent the water from coming up over the top. His plan is to pour a concrete cap on top of the existing wall. Ms. Emerson said the rocks are irregular and she wanted to know how he was going to do the work. He said he was going to scribe with a board. He plans to start after the drawdown. It will be done in five sections. The Commission looked at the pictures. Mr. Snow saw the DEP comments and went along on the site visit and was satisfied with the proposed work.

d. 6:45 p.m. Continued the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent and SW Permit

for Colin Derhammer

Property: Charlton & Bacon Hill Road, Spencer, MA DEP#293-1040

Calisto Bertin, President of Bertin Engineering, joined the meeting (remotely). Ms. Mclaughlin reviewed Adrienne Lennon's letter. There was a discussion about the water quality report. Mr. Bellemer said that the ad in the paper stated there was supposed to be a report done on Charlton Bacon Road & Ash Street Subdivision. Mr. Bertin said he did file in July for the water quality certification for both properties.

Aaron Hutchins, from 225 Charlton Road, said that he could not understand how the stormwater reviewer could not find any stormwater issues. Ms. McLaughlin read the letter stating that Dominic Rinaldi completed the stormwater analysis. Mr. Hutchins said he wrote to MA DEP. He does not want this project to move forward. The wetlands will continue to drain downhill where his property is located. Mr. Bertin said that Mr. Hutchins home is impacted by the 50 acres of hill behind his property. Mr. Hutchins said that he loses a third of his land due to water coming off the hill, which was originally designed to flow through his property out of the wetland. Now, the plan is to make it larger on the side of the hill. Mr. Bellemer asked Mr. Hutchins if there was a stream through his yard before they did the forestry work. Mr. Hutchins said the stream was there, but never as much as it is now. Mr. Hutchins wants BSC to tell him where the water is going to go. Mr. Bertin said that they propose to put an inlet in on the corner of the property. Jeff Bridges, Town Administrator, asked Mr. Bertin if they could meet out at the property with Aaron Hutchins. Mr. Bellemer suggested that Dominic Rinaldi, the stormwater reviewer, meet with them as well. Mr. Bridges suggested continuing to the next meeting so that staff can prepare the conditions. David Nussey, 227 Charlton Road, asked about the blasting. Mr. Bellemer gave Mr. Nussey some information on blasting.

At the request of the Commission, the hearing is continued to 9/27/23.

e. 7:21 p.m. Continued the Public Hearing for the Notice of Intent and SW Permit for Colin Derhammer

Property: R27-1 Ash Street, Spencer, MA DEP#293-1037

Calisto Bertin, President of Bertin Engineering, said that they had a review letter from Haley Ward and they submitted a response to the letter. They adjusted some of the items and he wanted to review them tonight. They did not need a permit from Dam Safety. They did submit water quality calculations. They changed the berm basin next to the neighbor's property to a small retaining wall. Mr. Bellemer wanted to know how difficult it is to maintain the jellyfish. Mr. Bertin said that they have a maintenance schedule and they can adjust it based on the findings. Matt Burne, from BSC Group, said that he was satisfied with Mr. Bertin's response.

3. Other Business:

a. 4 Wildwood Lane - Enforcement Order - Plans

Peter Rourke said the septic plan was approved last night by Lisa, the Board of Health Agent. They decided to bring the tank and all the septic deliveries above the house. They propose a basin on the lakeside of Wildwood Lane with a riprap that would be 50-ft long. Ms. McLaughlin asked Mr. Rourke if the pipe was out of the water. Mr. Rourke said the pipe is out of the water. He said his neighbor has a pipe in the water as well. Ms. McLaughlin asked him how he is getting over the isolated wetland. Mr. Rourke said that they put in measures to mark the land. They will go around the buffer on the right side with a mini excavator. The Commission would like the list of the plants. They would like the proposed work to be completed September 13, 2024

Mr. Burtt wanted to know if he had to plant 55 plantings. The Commission said he did, but they do not have to be only trees. They could be bushes and shrubs as well. The Commission would like updated plans by the next meeting.
